The *International University Preparatory Diploma* program is an honors program for high achieving Secondary students who plan to pursue a university career overseas, especially in the United States or Canada.

What course of secondary study is right for me?

The program utilizes a state of the art educational system that allows a student to self instruct as well as being lectured and mentored by highly qualified teachers.

Students are challenged to achieve highest academics while also participating in a well rounded secondary program which includes community service, student government, sports, and international field trips, a program that is designed to help them achieve admission in top ranking universities.

When a student enters the program he or she will sit with a counselor and discuss their long term educational and career goals. The first two years (Form 3 & 4) students will take general subjects. Then before they enter Form 5 their long term goals will again be considered and they will focus their last two years of secondary on a course of study to prepare them for the particular university course of study they want to pursue. After successfully completing the required number of credits for an International University Preparatory Diploma, students will graduate with the equivalent of a High School Diploma. To reinforce the Diploma, they will take the SAT or ACT (external examinations accepted by many universities

world wide and required by USA universities) in Form 5 and again in Form 6.



Students can possibly take Advanced Placement courses as well for university advanced placement.
