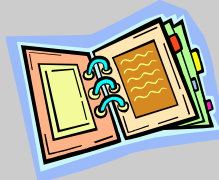

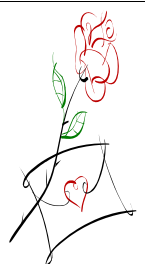
Please feel free to give Mr. Chambwa and the kids a card or whatever you may. You may drop it off at the front desk in the administration building.

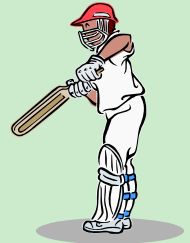
