## End of year exams for Secondary begin November 9

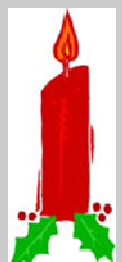

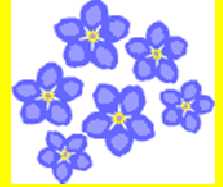


## Thursday, November 19 – Upside Down Day ....
