We are so glad to see most of our students back again. We need to remind you that it is time to make Third Term payments. Payments for Third Term should be paid no later than August 31 in order to avoid late payment fees. Third Term begins September 1.

Enrolment for 2021

We are now enrolling for 2021. It is important each year that we know which of our students intend to continue at TLCS in the coming year. We have families waiting to attend and so we ask that you secure your child's place for 2021 by depositing P1000 for a single child, P1800 for two or more. This is a **non-refundable deposit**. This deposit will go towards first term fees for 2021. **Deadline for this deposit is September 28th**. After that, we will begin filling the classrooms with children on our waiting lists.

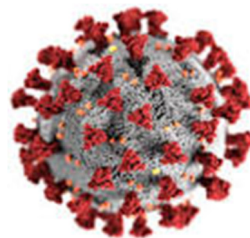

Term 3 Uniform Guidelines

A reminder that third term uniforms return to our normal uniform and dress code mandates properly fitting uniforms.

- * Long pants for boys should cover the top part of their shoes. (They should not be above their ankles)
- * Skirts are to be mid-knee length. Blazer/jersey sleeves should cover their wrists.
- * Shirts worn under the uniform blouse/shirt must be white. Proper socks – not the invisible kind are designated school uniform code.



CLOSED CAMPUS

Please remember that due to COVID19 our campus is **CLOSED**. That means that you must have an appointment to come to the school. Please do not just show up as we will not be able to allow you to come past the entrance hall. Parents dropping lunch from home may drop the lunch at the entrance and it will be delivered to the student.

SESSIONS:

When we scheduled our second term sessions with COVID in mind, we first consulted with local pediatricians. They recommended to us that students have constancy. Their comment was that as long as we have a good environment for learning, the timing is not so important. Children are resilient and able to learn well at all times. We do not plan to alternate the sessions but rather will keep the students in the same place for the remainder of the year. We anticipate that COVID mandated social distancing will continue until we finish this year.
