MORNING SESSION:

GATES OPEN FOR STUDENTS AT 0630.

Please make sure you arrive on campus in a timely manner so that your child can go through the entrance procedures and make it to class on time. In the morning session, class starts at **0700**. **We have some families arriving at 0730. When you do that, your child is missing 30 minutes of class time.**

Dismissal:

Morning session for preschool and primary dismisses at 11:30.

AFTERNOON SESSION:

Students should not be dropped before 12:00. Please take note of this. Students arriving for the afternoon session will be processed for entry only from 12:15. Students should be on campus for 12:30 start to classes.

NOTE:

Late pickup will apply to both morning and afternoon sessions.

Communications

When communicating to the school regarding your child, please make sure to include their name, class teacher's name and their account number. That information allows us to respond in a more efficient manner.

Enrolment for 2022

We are now enrolling for 2022. It is important each year that we know which of our students intend to continue at TLCS in the coming year. We have families waiting to attend and so we ask that you secure your child's place for 2022 by depositing P1000 for a single child, P2000 for two or more. This is a **non-refundable deposit**. This deposit will go towards first term fees for 2022. **Deadline for this deposit is September 1st**. After that, we will begin filling the classrooms with children on our waiting lists.



We have relaxed our uniform policy for the winter so students are as warm as possible.

Suitable indoor items of clothing will be allowed this term, in addition to TLCS uniform. We recommend that students wear clothes as close to our school colours as possible – preferably blue and black.

P.E.

- School tracksuit

- Black or navy long bottoms
- Black or navy warm sweater or jacket
- PE shorts paired with black or navy joggers/leggings
- White long sleeve vest/thermal under PE t-shirt

- White/black/blue turtle necks and or thermals
- Heavier coat or jacket as the most outer layer
- Blue or black stockings under school dress or skirt
